MERLOT:

All we can say is wow, again, a proven genetic to boast large yields of citrus/cherry laden flowers ranging from beautiful purples to light shades of green. This strain was planted fairly late all throughout California and amazed growers with it explosive growth and yields – if only you could imagine the size of plants

Heritage: Cherry wine X Cherry B Recommended spacing:

6X6 can vary based on planting time

Harvest Time: beginning October

WU5:

This indica dominant strain is unlike anything we've seen! She a slow vegging plant, so try to get in before July! Very stable, uniform growth throughout the whole line that is extremely mold resistant, the flowers are so trichome packed it will blow minds. and if that doesn't the smell will- hints of SFV OG and sweet OG are reminiscent. Once again, this strain will grow literal rock hard flower that are the prettiest we have EVER seen!

Harvest Time: Mid to Late October

Heritage: Unknown Israeli Strain


AUTO 3.0:

One of the best, consistent auto flowers we have ever witnessed. Superb stability with some of the largest yields of any auto-flower in the world. Flowers tend to be of medium density, great for smokable flower or biomass!

Heritage: Unknown Flower to finish: 80-90 days Plants per acre: 7000-10,000 Yield: 3000-5000 lbs an acre



EARLY GIRLS



EB ABACUS

This is the holy grail of fast growing, early finishing genetics. Not an auto flower but finishes 1st week of September, average around 1.5-2 lbs of good biomass per plant. Has minor cannabinoids of CBDV and CBC which comes out to be almost 5% in extracted oil. Can grow higher plants per acre for phenomenal biomass weight per acre. Great for large scale hemp farming, and northern climates prone to early rainy seasons.

Harvest time: 1st week of September Yield: 3500-10,000 lbs an acre

ABACUS 2.0:

This cultivar is superb for high end smokable flower, boasting a true OG terpene profile. We truly believe this is the pinnacle of smell, flavor and looks when it comes to cbd flower!
